### **Note by the Secretary-General**

1. Pursuant to section I, paragraph 8, of General Assembly resolution [49/233 A](#), the present note reflects the approved resources for peacekeeping operations, the United Nations Logistics Base at Brindisi, Italy, and the support account for peacekeeping operations for the period from 1 July 2013 to 30 June 2014 (see annex).
