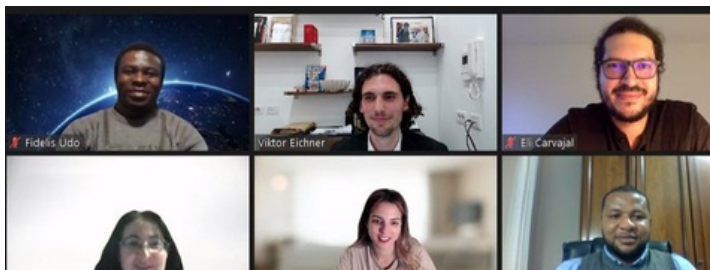

UPEACE facilitated dialogue with representatives of indigenous and native peoples of Honduras

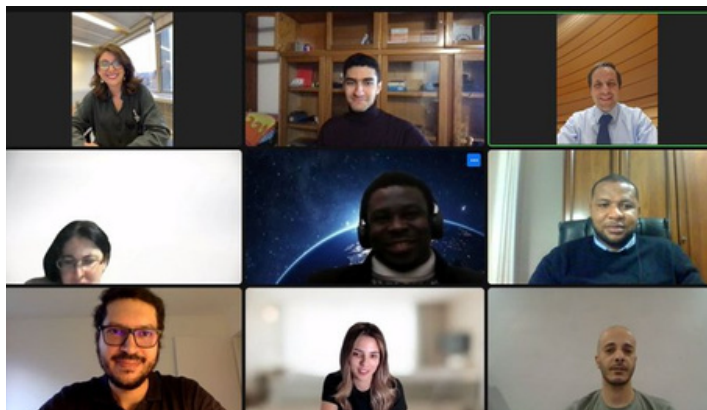
