The high-level event marked the launch of the Peace Principles (P4P) in Somalia and the integration of the eight principles into the National Reconciliation Framework; which address dignity, solidarity, humility, legitimacy and accountable security, pluralism, embracing subsidiarity and advocating for integrated and hybrid solutions. Among those in attendance were the Prime Minister, H.E. Hamza Abdi Barre; the Minister of Interior, Federal Affairs and Reconciliation, H.E. Ahmed Fiqi; the Minister of Information, Culture and Tourism, H.E. Daud Aweis; and the representative of the United Nations Assistance Mission in Somalia, among other participants. UPEACE students and alumni moderated the event's discussion groups. Their final reports will serve as a basis for P4P to prepare for implementation in Somalia.
